The VCU EM Residency held it's annual celebration of the holiday season on December 13th. Each resident received VCU EM socks funded from faculty and alumni donations.

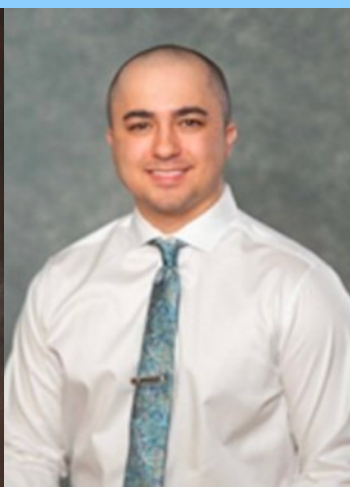

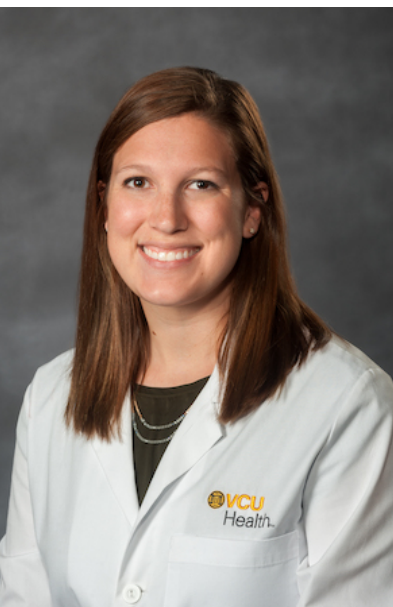

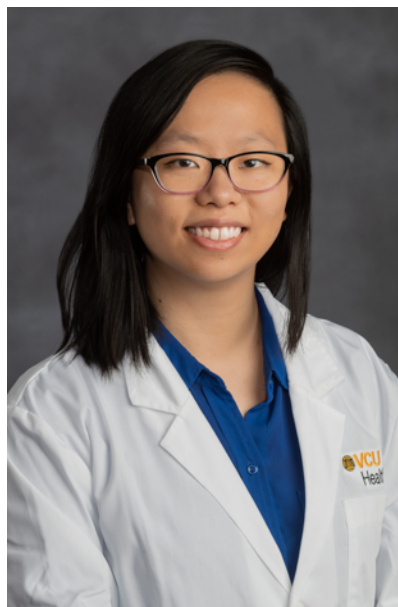
